Lawyer Says Wilson Seeks Political Publicity in Case Involving Murder

Philadelphia, Nov. 27 (AP)—Mary K. O'Connor's attorney accused Mayor S. Davis Wilson today of seeking "political publicity" in the investigation of the death of Nancy Glenn, five, in which Miss O'Connor was held without bail.

Attorney William A. Gray, declared the Mayor was investigating the case "because he likes publicity." "He is the judge and the prosecutor," said Gray. "He has not referred the case to the district attorney, and is usurping the authority of every magistrate in Philadelphia."
