C. H. Guité presented the following proposition for the better observance of the fifth of July, and it was referred to the committee on memorial service.

Resolved, that, so far as practicable, we will make a special effort to have our congregations and Sunday school observe the 4th of July of next year as a day consecrated to the promotion of the temperance reform.
