**TO BE GUEST SPEAKER**  
Judge Nathan Turk will be guest speaker at the one hundredth anniversary celebration of Frontier City Lodge 422, F. & A. M. Friday evening, June 7.

Judge Turk of Owego, Grand Master of Owego Lodge, Free and Accepted Masons of the State of New York, served as County Judge and Surrogate of Tioga County from 1925 to 1936. A lawyer and a graduate of Syracuse University, Judge Turk is a member of the Tioga County, New York State and American Bar Association.

A Mason for many years, Judge Turk is a member and Past Master of Candor Lodge, 11 and an Honorary member of many Lodges. He has held office as Deputy Grand Master, Junior Grand Warden, District Deputy Grand Master of the Chemung-Schuyler-Tioga Masonic District, and has served on the Grand Lodge Committees on Enrollments and Survey.

Judge Turk has been a leader in his District in the Masonic Brotherhood Fund Campaigns during which one

half million dollars has been raised for Rheumatic Fever Research; 750,000 dollars for the new Masonic Medical Research Center now under construction in Utica, New York, and 500,000 dollars for continuing research there on completion January 1, 1957.

He is also a member of several affiliated Masonic Bodies including Royal Arch Masons, the Knights Templar, Scottish Rite, Royal Order of Scotland, the Red Cross of Constantine and the Shrine. He is a 33° Honorary.

Judge Turk is active in community affairs and has long been a member of the Owego Kiwanis Club and served as Lieutenant Governor of the State for the Kiwanis organization. He is a member of the Board of Visitors of the Elmira Reformatory and takes an active interest in prison reform and Juvenile Delinquency.

A dinner will be served at 6:30 p. m. at the West Baptist and First Methodist Churches both on West Fourth Street. At 7:45 p. m. the Centennial Program will begin in the Oswego High School Auditorium.

After the initial eight weeks, he will be given a two-week leave and receive eight more weeks of advanced Infantry training, be enrolled in one of the specialist schools conducted here or be transferred to another Army post for training in one of the Army's technical schools.
