Little, Ogdensburg Editor, Publisher and World Traveler, will be the principal speaker at 2:00 p.m. following the always popular Annual Luncheon at 1:00 p.m. He will speak on "My Recent Trip Through Russia and the Satellite Countries with the American Newspapers Study Mission."

The complete agenda on the scheduled program of this October 23rd Meeting calls for the registration of all Delegates, Alternates, and attending Members between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.; a Board of Directors Meeting at 9:15 a.m. to 10:15 a.m. in the Drum Room at which each Member Club has been requested to have their Director present or a designated representative as there are several important matters to be decided: a Business Meeting at 10:15 a.m. to 12 noon with all members welcome. At this morning business session reports will be made by District Chairmen, and Department Chairmen will conduct workshops and present program material for use by the local Clubs in the Federation. The President's address will be made by Mrs. Dodds as the closing feature of the Business Meeting. Between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. a reception will be held for Members to meet the Guest Speaker and Guest Artists on the Musical Program.

Luncheon will be served at 1:00 p.m. with a splendid Musical Program in charge of Mrs. James A. Kambertz of the Music Committee who has arranged for Miss Thayne Shaw of Clayton, N.Y. accompanied by Miss Nancy Haller to present vocal solos.

The Guest Speaker, Mr. Little, has long enjoyed the reputation of being an impressive speaker because he has the happy faculty of relating his observations with fascinating accuracy and at the same time interpreting the trends of public thinking in Countries whose Governments are under Communist control. Mr. Little, a graduate of Princeton University, is a native of Colorado where his parents were pioneer settlers and where he first began his newspaper career. ## Hunters' Reminder

New York hunters were reminded today that October 16 is the deadline for applying for a "party permit" to take an additional deer during the regular big game season.

According to the Conservation Department, permit applications have been coming in at a rapid pace since the start of the application period on September 27. Quotas for six of the 12 permit areas have been filled including Areas D and E in the Catskills, Areas B and N in the Adirondacks, Area G in western New York and Area I in the Hudson Valley.

The Department said permits are still available for Areas A, C and M (party of 3) in the northern Adirondacks and Areas F, H, I and J in western New York.

Applications are honored on the basis of earliest postmark. Applications received after an Area quota has been filled are immediately returned to the applicant.

New York's big game gunning season starts Oct. 25 in the Northern Zone, including the Adirondacks, and Nov. 15 in the rest of the State.

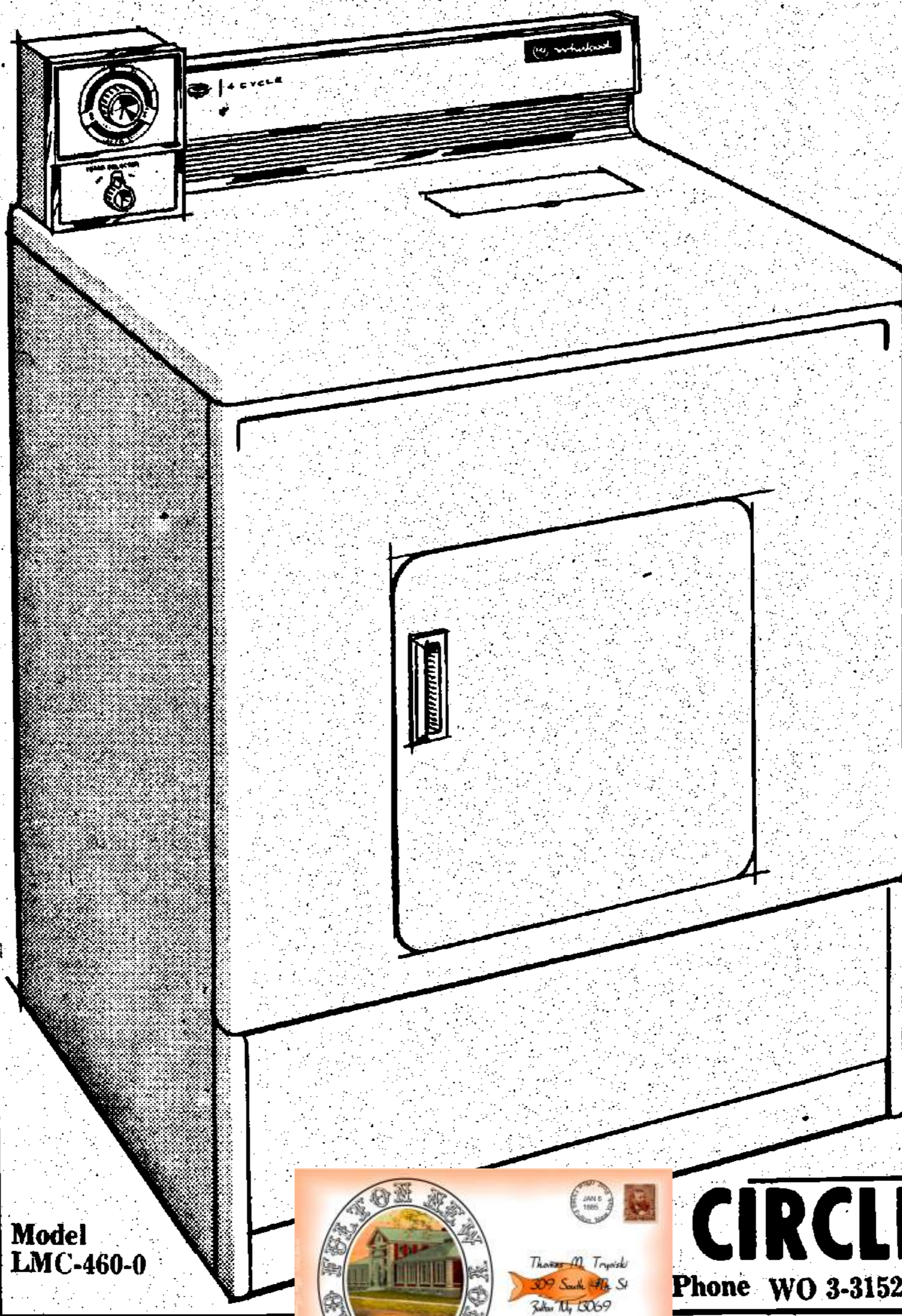
