OPEN LETTER TO NEW CENTURY CLUB AND TOWN RESIDENTS

We the Members of the Town Board of Mexico, have no objections of receiving a signed petition by the Residents of the Town of Mexico regarding the Junk Car Law as defined in Section 136 of the General Municipal Law which became affected September 1965.

In January 1966 the Town Board appointed Zoning Officer and since then he has been working on places that could be classified as Automobile Junk Yards.

We find of the 122 that signed the Petition 28 were residents of the Township and 94 were residents of the Village of Mexico. There were 3 persons signing twice and 1 person residing outside of the Township.

This situation is something that cannot be cleaned up over night and has to be worked on over a period of time to correct.

For your information we are listing places that the Zoning Officer has called on and the results of his visits. Most of these checks required from 2 to 4 trips.

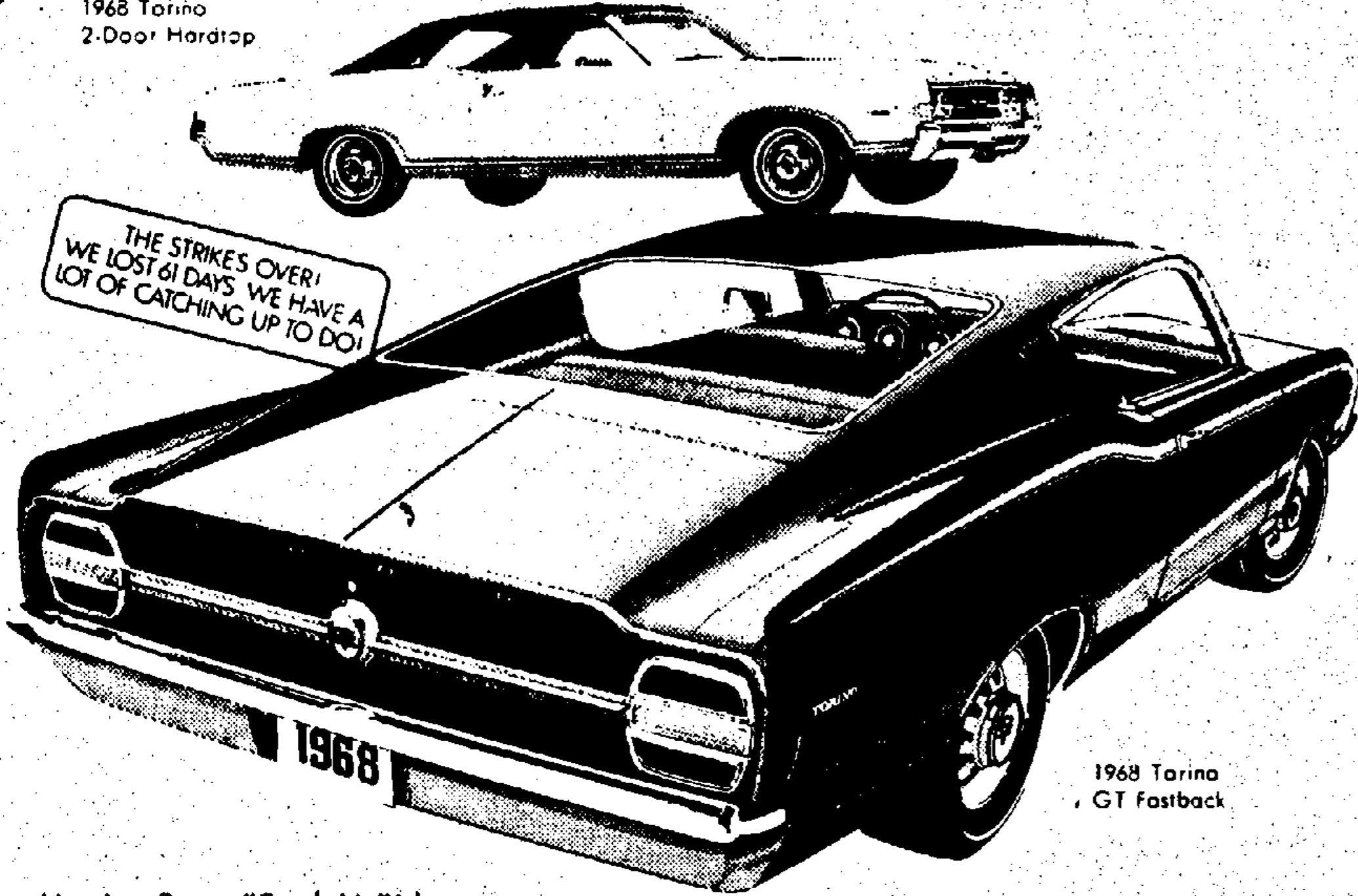
