Appointed Manager At Oswego

The appointment of George K. Kallenbach as project manager of Niagara Mohawk's generation expansion at Oswego was announced today by Thomas J. Brosnan, vice president and chief engineer for the utility.

Kallenbach joined Niagara Mohawk in 1931 as a sub-station operator and served in a number of engineering posts in the company's eastern division at Albany. In 1956 he was named superintendent of operation for the eastern division and in 1965 he was appointed system operations engineer in Syracuse, his present post.

Kallenbach is a member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers and past Chairman of its nationwide Transformer Committee. He also serves on the Transformer Sectional Committees of the American National Standards Institute.

A native of Fallon, Nev., Kallenbach is an electrical engineering graduate of the University of Nevada.
