Selective Service Draft Board Announces New Classifications

"A I-Y classification has been added for Selective Service registrants", Chairman Ernest Miller of Local Board No. 60, told the Patriot this week.

In Class I-Y will be placed registrants who are found not qualified by the armed forces for military service under current physical, mental and moral standards, but who are considered to be qualified to serve in an emergency.

This does not replace the IV-F classification because in that class will be placed all registrants who are considered not qualified for military service under any conditions.

"Current standards of physical, moral and mental acceptability are higher than those which the armed forces would use in an emergency", Mr. Miller explained.

The new classification permits the ready identification "by day of men who are considered to be qualified and available in an emergency, and thus facilitates the rapid mobilization of manpower in case of need."

Miller stated there is presently a sizable group of registrants of this local board who have completed their physical examinations, failed to qualify for military service who have not been reclassified from I-A. Men in this group will now be reclassified into Classes I-Y or IV-F depending on whether they are considered to be qualified for service in an emergency or totally unqualified to serve.
