

## Fred Alderman Selected for Study in Florence, Italy

Fred Alderman, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward N. House, 556 West First St., Fulton, has been selected by Syracuse University to study in Florence, Italy, for the next semester. Fred will study at the University of Florence, Italy, where he will live and study until June.

Fred is one of approximately 50 students selected each semester by Syracuse University to study in Florence. To be accepted, the student must possess the necessary academic potential and maturity required for successful study in a foreign country. In order to qualify the student should maintain an average, submit an application, submit three character references, and have a series of interviews. On the basis of these aspects, the candidates are chosen.

As a junior at Syracuse University, Fred is enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts and is majoring in both Fine Arts and Advertising. While in Florence, he will take seven credit hours of Italian and nine hours of art history and oil painting. Aside from an intensive two hour drill each day in Italian class each student is placed in an Italian home where no English is spoken. Therefore, general after six weeks or so, the American student has a fair command of the language.

In the past two and a half years, Fred has been very active in campus activities. He was a member of the committee for Frosh Weekend, was appointed to the Dorm Council, and was very active on the Dorm Art Council. Last year two of his paintings were selected to be exhibited at the Festival of The Arts Exhibition; and in the near future, his photographic essay on "The Guns of Carrara" will be part of the Syracuse University Photography Exhibition.

In this past semester, Fred as a Boar's Head Apprentice (Dramatic Honorary), starred in Glenn Hughes' "Red Carnations," a light comedy presented at Dr. Joseph Golden's Nickel Theatre on the Coronet Stage. Fred also appeared in "Scenes From 'Summer a Smoke,'" by Tennessee Williams, a collection of scenes presented by Director Bea Shaktman at the Regent Theatre. Aside from these, Fred worked on lighting and stage design of "The Gun of Carrara" by Bertolt Brecht which ran as an American premiere at the Regent last October. He also worked on the production of "The Innocents," which was presented on Coronet Stage.
