Area farmers to receive conservation funding The Oswego County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service has been approved for two 1985 Agricultural Conservation Program Special Projects.

These special funds will be used to offer to farmers cost-share assistance to help them install various soil and water conservation practices.

The first USDA funded special project will offer to pay 50 percent of the cost of a farmer-owned or operated Salton and Little Salmon River Watersheds. No-till does not use conventional methods of tillage. Simply stated, no-till is planting one crop into the residue of a previous crop. Very little of the tilling of the surface is disturbed as it would be in conventional tillage.

The second USDA funded special project will offer to pay 75 percent of the farmer's cost of a farmer-owned or operated conservation construction practices on their farmland. Applications for cost-share assistance are not being taken at the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) Office located on Main Street in Mexico. As farmers interested in cost-share assistance should sign up by March 8.
