

Monitoring program will begin at solid waste plant

Arthur Ospelt, Oswego County Superintendent of Public Works, has announced the initiation of a compliance monitoring program at the county's solid waste facilities. The Department of Public Works, utilizing summer

employees, has started a two-month program of residential permit monitoring and educational information regarding the county's solid waste regulations.

A summer employee will be assigned to each transfer station in the county to check the permit stickers of all residential vehicles entering county facilities.

In instances where residents do not have permits, stickers will be issued upon verification of Oswego County residency. The employees will also distribute informational literature explaining the local solid waste regulations.

Additionally, several times during the summer period, surveys will be conducted to obtain statistics on the number of daily transfer station users, the type of

use, place of residency, and peak time periods of use.

"All of this information will be utilized in an evaluation of the residential permit system," said Ospelt. "The permit system has been in place approximately two years in our department, and the Public Works Committee of the Legislature wants to review its effectiveness and review potential alternatives to improve the system. Thanks to the availability of the Legislature's summer employment program, we will have the additional help to collect the information necessary for this evaluation."

Ospelt also reminded county residents that use of the county's solid waste facilities requires a resident's permit, which is provided free of charge by the county upon verification of Oswego County residency. These permits may be obtained at any county transfer station or by contacting the county's Division of Solid Waste, phone 592-7441. Industrial and commercial users must have a special permit; applications may be obtained by contacting the Division of Solid Waste.

Oswego County's solid waste transfer are located on East Seneca Street, Oswego; Route 3, Volney; County Route 2A, Pulaski; Route 11, Hastings; and County Route 7, Hannibal.
