Fabric Damage by Moths

Each Spring as outdoor lights and warm weather bring moths to homes, residents become concerned that these creatures will do extensive damage to their stored woolens. What most homeowners do not realize is that the main group of fabric destroying insects includes only two moth species, whose habits send them into more secluded areas of the home. Damage from these species extends far beyond woolens as the larval stage has an avid appetite for any fabric containing Keratin—a protein of animal hair, feathers, animal horns and hooves. These moths are frequent pests of clothing, carpets, upholstery fabrics, piano felts, blankets, furs, brush bristles and any stored woolproducts. At times, moth larvae will damage products such as cotton, linen, silk, synthetic fibers and paper, but usually just as a means of reaching their desired food source.

House wives can aid greatly in the control of both the clothes moths and the carpet beetles by remembering that sanitation is the key to any effective pest prevention. Fabric's stained with such materials as oil from human hair, beer, tomato juice, soft drinks, milk and human sweat make a healthy diet for these pests. As a matter of fact, first instar larvae cannot survive on "clean" wool, but require the nutritional supplements found in soilage.

Frequent vacuuming, airing, and dry cleaning help eliminate breeding places. Old carpeting rolled up and stored, piles of bedding, and clothes stored for prolonged periods of time, and unattended heat radiators and registers where lint and animal hair are allowed to accumulate invite infestation.

It is to be remembered that these are preventative measures which coupled with professional moth proofing work to eliminate invasion. Once an infestation develops, corrective measures must be taken with contact spray and/or mist fogging best handled by a professional exterminator.

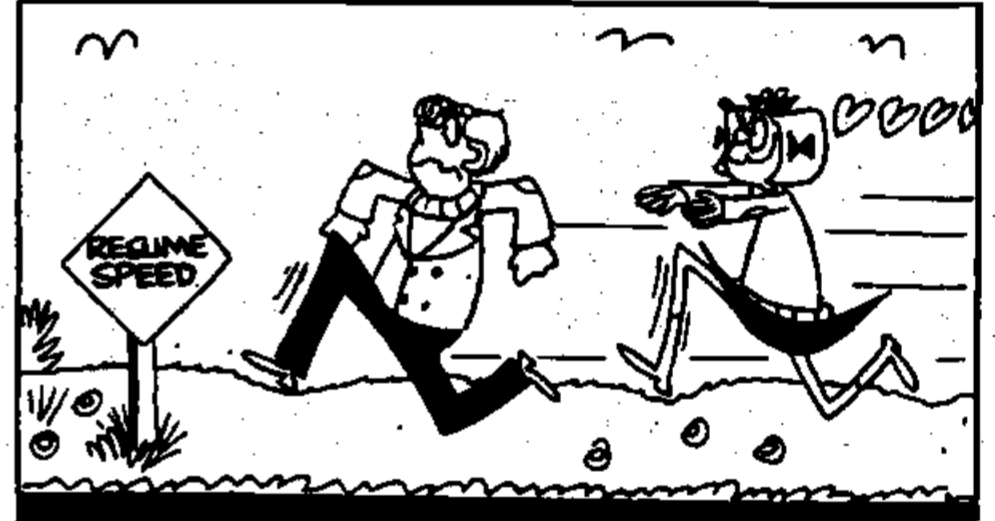
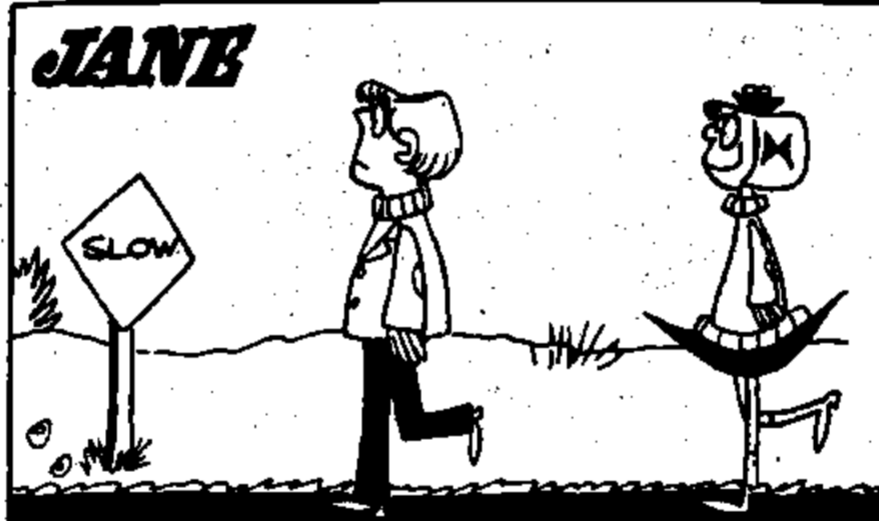
