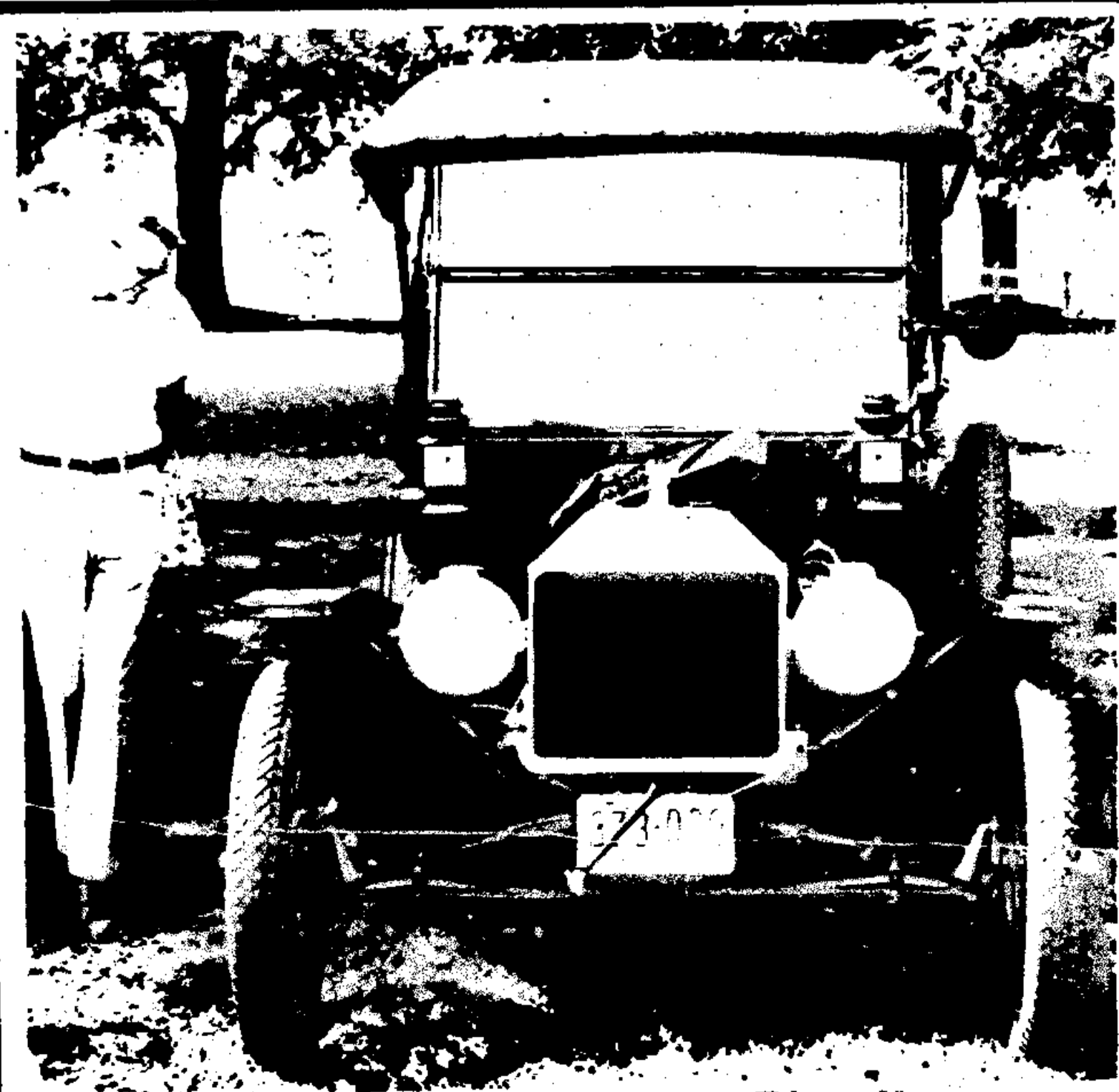

WONDERFUL INVENTION THE AUTOMOBILE

Someone once observed that no other single invention has made as profound a change in American life as did the automobile.

The days of the proverbially merry curved dash Oldsmobile, the duster, and the automobilist's goggles returned to Fort Ontario from noon to 5 pm on Labor Day, September 2, when the newly formed Pathfinder Antique Auto Club will cooperate with the New York State Office of Parks and Recreation in an exhibition of classic and antique automobiles on the grounds adjacent to Oswego's his-

toric fortress.

it was an opportunity for everyone interested in the evolution of the conveyance we take for granted today to recall the time when automobile travel in Central New York was a real adventure if not always a convenience.

Albert T. Hartmann of Fulton, President of the Pathfinder Antique Auto Club, and Wallace F. Workmaster, Acting Regional Supervisor of Historic Sites and President of the Oswego County Historical Society, invited anyone interested in displaying an antique car to participate in the event. A special dashboard plate

was presented to each automobile exhibited.

Other events of the "Weekend of History" were the final 1974 season appearances of the volunteer costumed hostesses sponsored by The Heritage Foundation of Oswego and of the award-winning Fort Ontario Guard.
