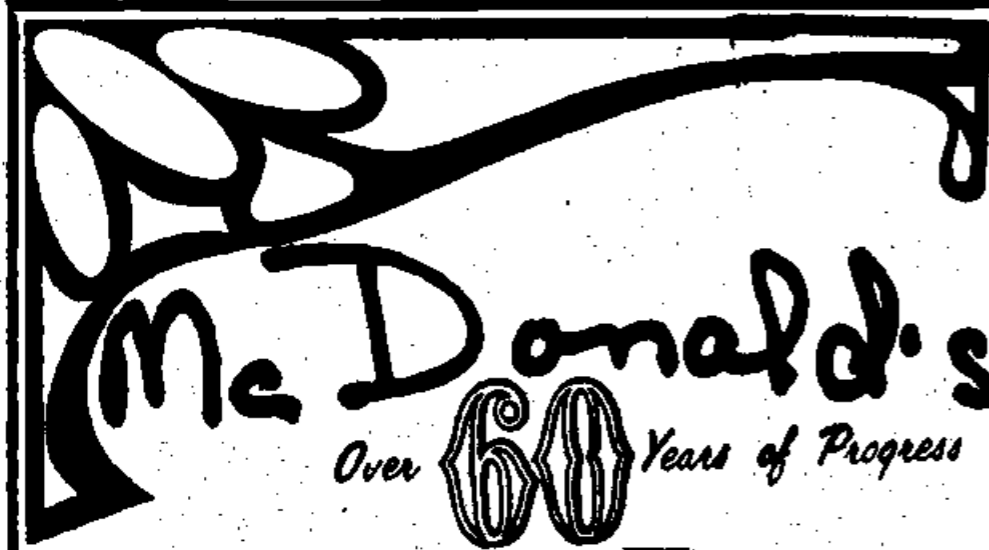

**Labor Force Survey**

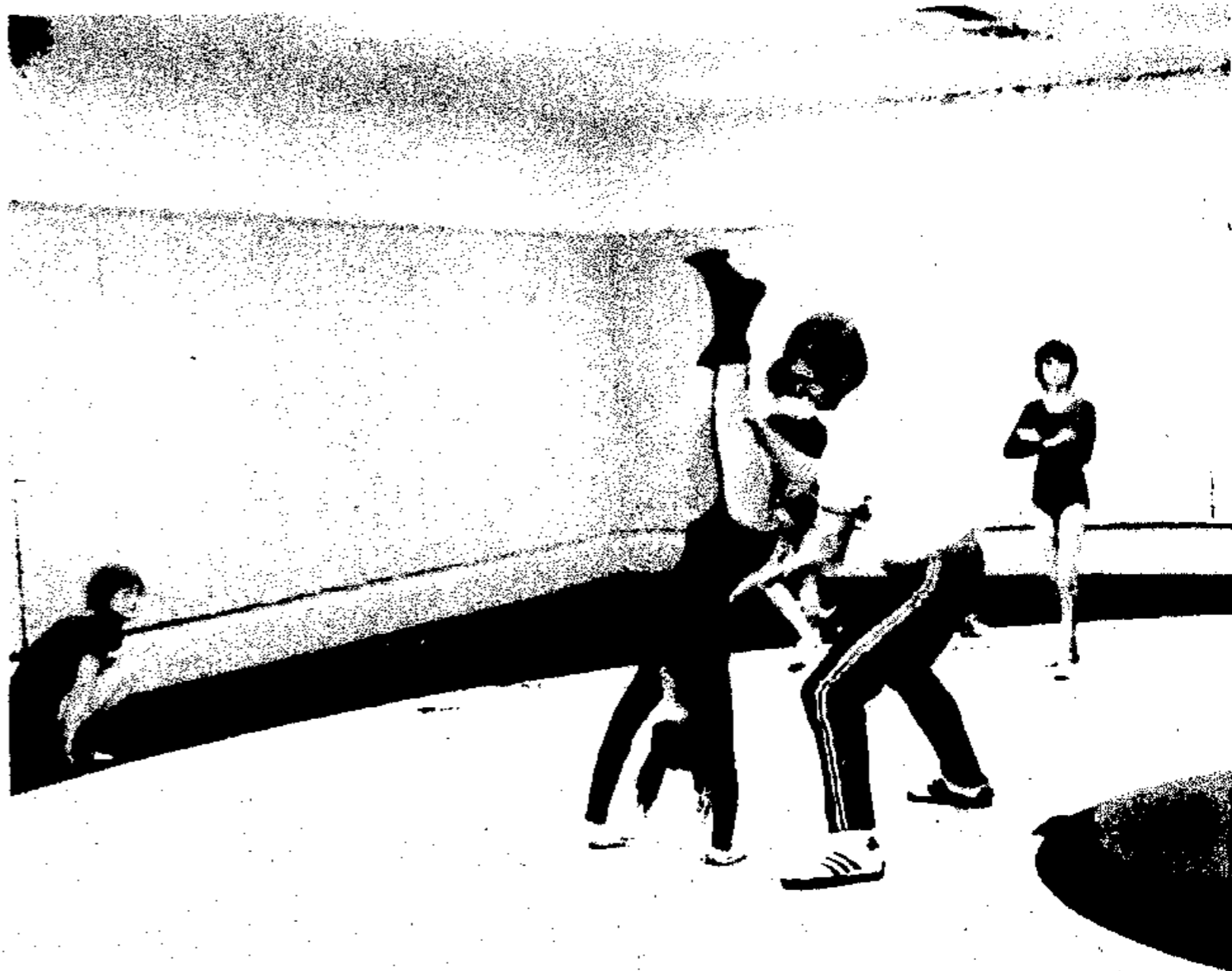
Local representatives of the Bureau of the Census will conduct a survey of employment and unemployment in this area during mid-August. Arthur G. Dukakis, Director of the Bureau's Regional Office in Boston announced today.

In addition to the usual questions on current employment, the August survey will have additional questions about the use of food stamps in 1975.

The survey is conducted monthly by the Bureau for the U.S. Department of Labor in a scientifically designed sample of about 60,000 households throughout the entire United States. The employment and unemployment statistics which are based on results of this survey are used to provide a continuing measure of the economic health of the Nation.

For example, the June survey indicated that unemployment declined in June, and employment was about unchanged. The unemployment rate dropped 8.6 percent in June from 9.2 percent in May. Total employment remained steady at 84.8 million. Since last September total employment has fallen by nearly 2 million.

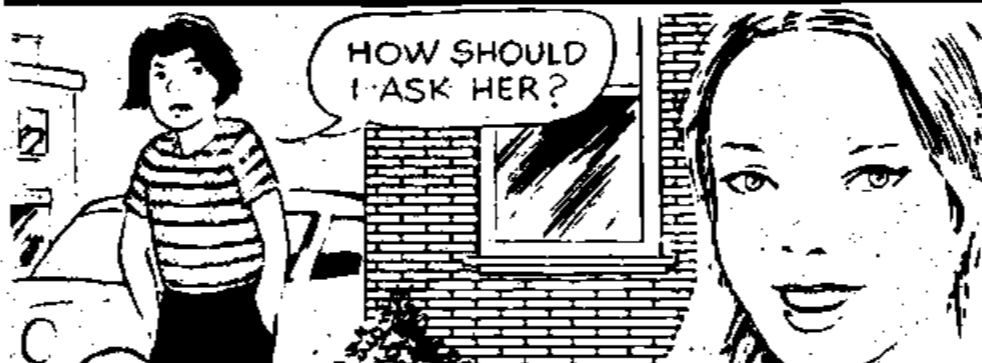
