Phoenix Parents Reminded of Requirements For Kindergarten Registration in Fall

Registration for those children eligible to begin Kindergarten at the Elm Street School in Phoenix next September will be held Tuesday, May 9, 1972 between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. and between 7 and 9 p.m. at the school.

The requirements for children entering school in September 1972 are that they be five years of age on or before December 1, 1972 and that they have been immunized against Smallpox, Measles (both varieties), Polio, and Diphtheria.

Therefore, parents wishing to register a child for September entrance into Kindergarten must have the following items with them at registration time:

(1) Proof of the child's birth date (Birth Certificate or Baptismal Certificate).

(2) The dates when the child has received immunization against Smallpox, Measles, both varieties (two-week - Regular; three-day - German), Polio and Diphtheria.

The above two items are required by State Law and registration cannot be completed unless "proof of age" is presented along with the dates the child received the five immunizations.

It is recommended that children who have not received the required immunizations do so between now and May 9, 1972 so that the child's registration can be completed on that date.

If there are any questions regarding Kindergarten registration, on whether your child should begin Kindergarten even though he meets the age

requirement, please contact Mr. McGuire, Principal of the Elm Street School, at 695-1561, and discuss the matter with him.

Navy Increases Pay

The Navy has raised salaries for enlistees by over \$2000 per year it was announced today by Chief Petty Officer Tom Masuicca, Navy Recruiter in Oswego.

The increase has doubled the salaries of enlistees and has brought the monthly pay up to \$288 for the new recruit and boosted salaries to \$320.70 per month of those completing basic training. Also included in the recent pay bill is a new basic allowance for quarters of over \$100 per month for enlisted personnel who are married.

Chief Petty Officer Masuicca stressed that the \$288 per month figure was only for members of the

enlisted ranks. Officers, he explained, start at a salary of \$531 per month. He also pointed out that other benefits for both enlistees and officers still include free medical and dental care, the tradition of world wide travel, and thirty days paid vacation each year.
