OASIS program keeps students learning

The seventh OASIS (Opportunity for Academic Success in School) got off to a good start Monday, July 10, with 109 students, 11 teachers, and 13 aides in attendance. OASIS is the Phoenix Central School District's elementary summer school program. Students entering grades one through five are eligible to attend.

The focus of the program is to review lessons taught in the previous grade. Emphasis is placed on reading, language arts, and math. Parental participation is an important component of the program since no busing is provided and parents need to

transport their children to school.

There will be an "I Can Do It Night" in early August where parents will come to school and have their children show them the academic projects they have been working on. Teachers in the program also make a home visit to each of their students' homes. They bring with them an activity kit which will be used by parents and children to reinforce what has been taught.

The Oswego County Chapter of the American Red Cross will be offering a Community CPR course Aug. 15 and 17 from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.

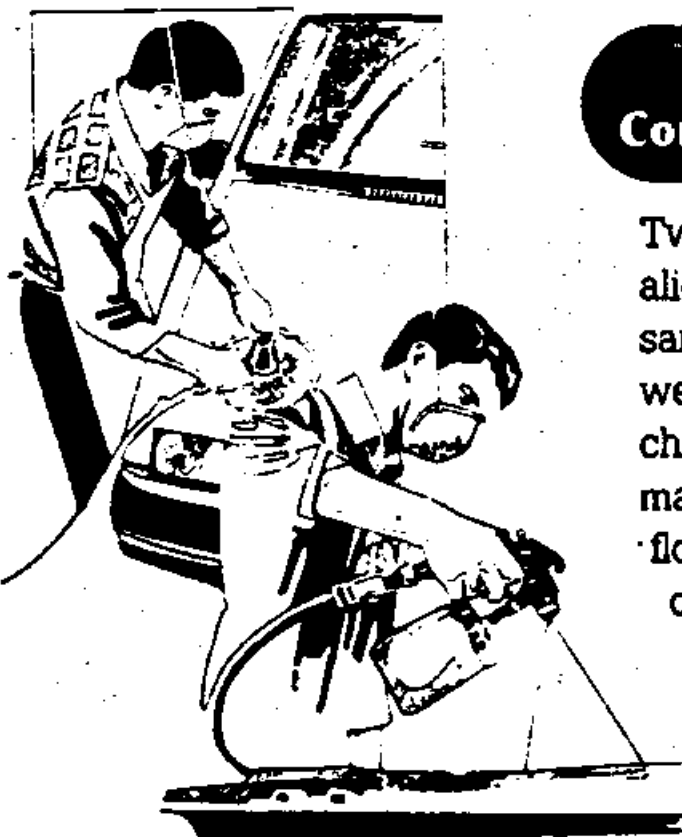

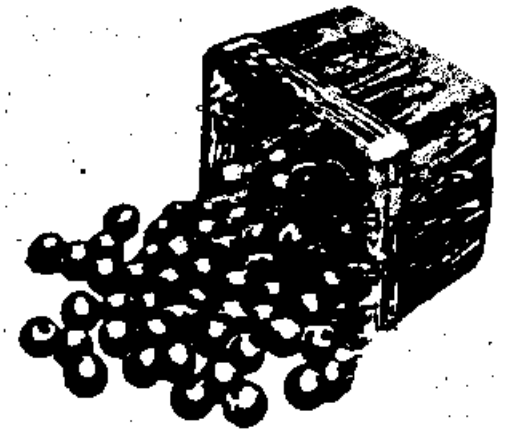
