Oswego Players to present *Come Blow Your Horn*

The upcoming Oswego Players production of *Come Blow Your Horn* will present a comedic look at early 1960s relationships. The play, written by Neil Simon, opened on Broadway in 1961.

Characters include a domineering father, doting mother, rebellious sons, a kooky neighbor/girlfriend, and a serious (I want to be married), girl-next-door type," an event representative said. "Simon's situations are always funny and this is no exception. The play, written nearly forty years ago, gives us a light-hearted glimpse of the moral climate and family interrelationships of the genre. Even with

the passage of time, *Come Blow Your Horn* remains good, solid entertainment everyone will enjoy. It contains no objectionable language or explicit sexual scenes."

The show is being directed by Carol DeCaprio with the assistance of Mary Hough as stage manager, Rosanne Schladebeck as production assistant, and Ginny Ranous as mentor. Technical details are being handled by John Wentworth, technical director for the Players. Scott Pucia and Ed Schladebeck are in charge of the stage lighting and Mark McCullough is responsible for set dressing and decoration.

Cast members include: a mix of veterans, Mark Mirabito, Sherri Baker, Larry Rose, and Freda Kocher; and newcomers Jon Schladebeck, Eileen Wentworth, and Sherida Martin.

Show dates are Friday and Saturday, June 25 and 26, and Thursday and Friday, July 1 and 2 at 8 p.m. in the Frances Marion Brown Theatre at the Oswego Arts Center in Fort Ontario Park.
