## Comic strip comes to life May 5 & 6

The colorful characters from the famous *Peanuts* comic strip by Charles Schulz will come to life at The Fulton Education Center Friday, May 5, 7:30 p.m. and Saturday, May 6, 3 and 7:30 p.m.

The Fulton Community Theatre production of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* with music and lyrics by Clark Gessner, is directed by Diana Gardiner with music direction by Lenore Hoxie. The six-person musical is the equivalent of flipping through a book of the comic strips, the show's producer Holly Otis explained.

"For children, this is a fun show because the storyline and music is easy to follow and entertaining to watch," Otis said. "For their parents, it's a chance to see those popular characters from our childhood."

According to Otis, all the elements from the comic strip are in this classic off-broadway musical by Clark Gessner. Charlie Brown and his famous kite, the red-haired girl we never see, the psychi-

atrist booth, Linus and his blanket, overbearing Lucy VanPelt, Patty, and yes, Schroeder and his baby grand piano.

Songs from the show include Supper-time, My Blanket and Me, The Kite, Little Known Facts, and the title song.

The *Charlie Brown* cast includes Glen Merrill as Charlie Brown, Debra Raff as Lucy, Lyndsie Mosher as Snoopy, Jeff Hodge as Linus, Jacob Wood as Schroeder and Stacey Gardiner as Patty.

Both Friday and Saturday evening performances are \$5 for all seats. The 3 p.m. matinee on Saturday, May 6 is \$4 with a donation of a can of food for the Fulton Food Pantry. Both Saturday performances will be interpreted for the hearing impaired. Funds for this service are provided in-part through a grant from the New York State Council on the Arts.
