Legislators host farmland preservation seminar Nov. 27

The Oswego County Legislature will host a farmland preservation seminar, featuring state lawmakers and agricultural experts, Monday, Nov. 27, at 1 p.m. in the Legislative Chambers of the County Office Building, 46 E. Bridge St., Oswego.

State Senator John McHugh (46th District), Assemblyman Ray Chesbro (117th District), Professor Nelson Bills of the Cornell University Agriculture Economics Department, and Francis Dellamano, Oswego County Cooperative Extension agent, will participate in the seminar. Senator McHugh is chairman of the State Legislative Committee on Rural Resources and a member of the state Farm Bureau Farmland Planning and Preservation Committee.

The seminar was organized by the County Legislature's Rural Resources and Extension Committee, chaired by Legislator Theodore Jerrett of New Haven, and the Economic Development and Tourism Committee, chaired by Legislator William Buck of Volney.

"Senator McHugh has championed the cause of our state's number one industry—agriculture," said Legislature Chairman Hollis J. Iselin. "Oswego County recognizes the farmland preservation issue, and we share increasing concern over legislative proposals regarding the loss of agricultural lands. We are an advocate of farmland preservation, and we invite all who share our concern to join us for an educational, informative afternoon."
