## Deline honored at police academy ceremony

At graduation ceremonies for the 25th annual Law Enforcement Explorer Police Academy, Alan DeLine of Fulton was awarded the Art Rivers Memorial Award which is presented "in recognition of outstanding service to the 1995 Explorer Police Academy."

DeLine was chosen for the award out of 83 law enforcement officers on the police academy staff. He is an advisor for Oswego County Sheriff's Department Post 744, along with Investigator Harland Fox Jr., and is a criminal justice instructor at the Burton Ramer Technical Career Center of Oswego County BOCES.

Over 350 Law Enforcement Explorers from six different states attended the resident police academy held at Westover

Air Force Base, Chicopee, Mass. They receive training in accident investigation, crime scene investigation, police ethics, first aid, firearms, and other police procedures.

The training includes a taste of what a real police academy will be like. The explorers have to get up at 6:30 a.m., take physical training, undergo strict room inspections, march to classes, etc.

The academy is not only designed to enhance future law enforcement career goals, but to offer the explorers an opportunity for social activities as well. There are dances scheduled at night, and they have access to swimming pools, bowling alleys, and the base gymnasium.
