are held and firmly bound unto the People of the State of New York, in the sum of Sixty one Hundred  
dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said people: To which payment well and truly to be made, we bind  
ourselves, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Isabella Dexter, the above bounden, of Mrs. Dexter  
of the Town of Volney in the County of Oswego, New York, deceased, has lately applied  
to the Surrogate's Court of the County of Oswego, New York, for authority to dispose, by mortgage, lease or sale, of so much of the real property  
of the said Mrs. Dexter, deceased, as shall be necessary to pay her debts and funeral expenses;  
and whereas such proceedings in due form of law have been thereupon had, that the Surrogate of said county has decreed a sale  
of so much of the real property thereof the said  
decedent died seized, as shall be necessary to pay the debts and funeral expenses of said decedent.

Now, the Condition of this Obligation is such, that if the said Isabella Dexter  
shall faithfully perform the duties imposed upon her by said decree,  
and shall pay into the Surrogate's Court of said County of Oswego, within twenty days after the receipt thereof by her, all money arising  
from any such sale, and shall deliver to the Surrogate of said County of Oswego, within the same time, all the securities taken thereupon, and  
shall account for all money received, by her, whenever she is required to do so by a court of competent jurisdiction; then this obligation  
to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
