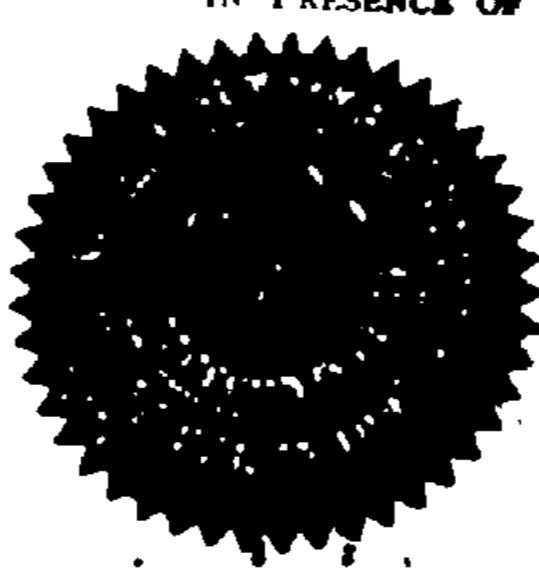
Whereas, the above bounden *Emetta A. Jackson* as *Executive of the estate of Frank E. Whelan*
