scribed on oath or affirmation, faithfully and honestly to discharge the duties of such Executor: hereby requir-

its of the said Testator within a reasonable time, and return a duplicate thereof to our Surrogate, of the County

of Oswego, within three months from the date of these presents; and if further personal property or assets of any

kind not mentioned in any Inventory, that shall have been so made, shall come to your possession or knowledge, to

make or cause to be made in like manner, a true and perfect Inventory thereof, and return the same within two

months after discovery thereof; and also to render a just and true account of the administration when thereunto re-

quired.

LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION.

Send Greeting:

Whereas William P. Curtis as is alleged, lately died intestate, being at or

Chattels and Credits of which the said intestate died possessed, and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the

account thereof, do belong unto our Surrogate of the County of Oswego: And we, being desirous that the Goods,

Chattels and Credits of the said intestate shall be well and faithfully administered, applied and disposed of, do grant

unto you the said James A. Curtis and James Cronbie

full power, by these Presents, to administer and faithfully dispose of all

and singular the said Goods, Chattels and Credits; to ask, demand, recover and receive the debts which unto the

said intestate, whilst living, and at the time of his death, did belong; and to pay the debts which the said intes-

tate did owe as far as such Goods, Chattels and Credits will thereto extend, and the law requires; hereby requiring
