Credits and also the auditing every office and keeping of the
Account thereof with relation to the said
administration of the said Goods and Chattels and Credits
of the said deceased and any way concerning the same
is granted and authorized unto the said Simon during the life-
time of the said deceased as aforesaid and know by the
Name & Reception of the said Simon being as aforesaid
in the said will annexed, the being the said Simon
the said Simon named and appointed in and by the said
will as is only provided by the said Charles May and
Capt. and Surgeon in and for said County. The said
Simon being a Justice of the Peace in the County of
Westchester and of the County of Albany being found
and faithfully to administer the said Goods and Chattels and
Credits and the said will, and to make and exhibit
a true and perfect Inventory of all the said Goods
and Chattels and Credits and also to receive
