the forty fifth in the County of Orange  
Charles Hayden <sup>County</sup> Sheriff of our said County of  
Orange the last will and Testament of John  
Amesbury deceased a copy of which is hereinafter  
inserted, was produced and is now on file and  
allowed of by us and the said Charles Hayden  
which he had and at the time of his death was  
wholly and truly within the power, by means whereof  
the proving and registering thereof will be the granting  
administration of all the goods the said Charles Hayden  
and truly and also the settling of all the debts  
owing the said Charles Hayden both before and after  
the administration of all the goods the said Charles Hayden  
and truly of the assets of said John Amesbury  
and truly is granted unto Samuel Sturson, one of  
the Executors therein named, with the execution hereof  
of the right of Charles S. Phelps and Stephen Bond  
also named in the said will of said Charles Hayden to  
the produce of the same if they shall offer therefor  
and in such case to administer jointly with the  
said Samuel Sturson. This said Samuel Sturson  
having been first duly sworn well and faithfully  
to administer the same and to exhibit a true  
and perfect inventory according to the best of his  
knowledge and ability of all and singular the goods  
wholly and truly within the power of the said Charles Hayden
