To all to whom these Presents shall come or may concern - Greeting - Know ye that at Oswego in the County of Oswego on the eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven before Joseph M. McKim Esquire Surrogate of our said County the last will and Testament of William Howe late of the City of St. John in the Province of New Brunswick deceased who lately died at Oswego a certain copy & hereof is hereto annexed was proved and is now approved and allowed of by us, and the said deceased having whilst he lived and at the time of his death goods chattels and credits within this State by means whereof the proving and registering the said Will and granting administration of all and singular the said goods chattels and credits, and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the account thereof doth belong unto us; The Administration of all and singular the said goods chattels and credits of the said deceased and in any way concerning his said will is granted unto Mrs. Mills as executrix in the said Will named she being first duly sworn well and faithfully to administer the same and to render and exhibit a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the
