Whereas Isaac Timmy Martin Willcox & James Beck commissioners appointed pursuant to the former order of the said court in the petition of Mrs. Dudley Burdick of Adeline Burnham Addison Burnham & Laura Burnham children & heirs of Samuel Burnham deceased for the admeasurement of the dower of Susannah London formerly the wife of the said Samuel Burnham but now the wife of Joseph London in certain lands & premises of the said Samuel Burnham deceased situate in the County of Oswego whereof the said deceased died seised of an estate of inheritance did on the 10th Day of May last make their report to the said Surrogate among other things that after having been sworn before legal authority faithfully honestly & impartially to discharge the duty & execute the trust reposed in them by the said appointment they did on the 10th Day of May last cause a survey to be made of the lands & premises in the said petition appointment & report mentioned as reference thereto being had will fully appear & that they had admeasured & allotted to the said Susannah London for her dower the one third part of the said lands & premises which third part so admeasured & allotted will fully appear by the said report the copy filed in the office of the said Surrogate & entered at large on his minute Book kept for that purpose and no cause appearing to the contrary it is therefore ordered that the said report & admeasurement be confirmed

At a Surrogate's Court held at Colgate in the County of Oswego the 10th day of May 1801 Present Joseph Terry, Surrogate  
Martha Canfield, the widow of Thomas Canfield, late of the Town of Tarry, in the County of Oswego, aforesaid, appeared (by counsel) and presented her petition praying for an order, that admeasurement of dower be made of the lands and premises in her said petition specified, and cause satisfactory proof of lawful service of a copy of the said petition, and notice of this application, and her marriage with, and of the death of the said Thomas Canfield, and her signs of the premises during the marriage, and after hearing the proof and allegations of the parties, it is ordered that admeasurement of the dower of the said widow be made of the lands of the said Thomas Canfield her husband, specified in her said petition, and further that Horace M. Ogilvie, Anne Sackett and Oliver Wendell, then reputable and disinterested freeholders, be appointed commissioners for the purpose of making such admeasurement.
