

The Order of the State of New York: A Calvin Tiffany
 William Mearns, and Calvin Goodwin, and setting
 Whereas, the said Calvin Goodwin, son of the said
 Hamilton, late of the Town of Albany, in the County of Albany
 deceased, lately presented his petition to Joseph Rogers, Sheriff
 of said County of Albany, praying for an order, pursuant to
 the several Statutes of this State, in such case made & pro-
 - vided, that an assessment of his said deceased, of the lands
 of the said Calvin Hamilton, deceased, situate in the said County
 of Albany, and also of the said deceased, and also of the said
 part of lot number forty one in Township number ten
 of the said County of Albany, were fully set forth and described in
 a deed from George Smith of the said County of Albany on
 the eighth day of August, and thereunto eight hundred and
 thirty seven and no more in the City and County of Albany
 of Albany on the third day of December 1828, in book G,
 of said page 515, also all that part of lot 42 of said Town
 of Albany, deceased which is set forth in a deed, from Thomas
 Hamilton & Adolph his wife on the 17th day of June 1829
 & recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County of Albany, on
 the 29th day of June 1830, in book F, of said page 574
 & 575, containing the area & quantity of said lands, to
 of an acre, also all that part of lot number forty one
 and forty two in said Township of Albany
 of Albany, deceased, being more fully set forth in a deed
 from George Smith and Adolph his wife, dated the 17th
 of August 1827 and recorded in the Clerk's
 Office of the said County of Albany, on the third day
 of December 1828 in book G, of said page 576 & 577, and
 also a piece of land containing about fifty one acres, of
 - which has been for some time past
 of the said Hamilton, the said pieces of land are
 received by Calvin Hamilton & the said Calvin Hamilton
 and claims the said Calvin Hamilton has been taken
 on the 29th day of June 1839, appeared in a Court before
 the said Sheriff held in the said County and made
 satisfactory proof of legal title of a copy of the said
 petition, and made a return in relation to the same
 in answer to your order, and also returned to your
 Hamilton, Gerrit Tiffany, William Mearns, William
 Mearns & Calvin Goodwin, sons of the said Calvin Hamilton
 deceased, and present owners of the same in said petition
 specified, also that the said Calvin Hamilton ever lawfully
 married to the said Calvin Hamilton and that the said
 Calvin Hamilton was during said marriage seized of an
 estate of inheritance in the said lands and that the said
 Calvin Hamilton died on the 17th day of
 of Albany in the year of our Lord one thousand eight

hundred - thirty three being seized at the time of his death
 of the said lands, and that the said lands are situate in the said
 County of Albany which said proofs were taken in the presence
 of the said Calvin Hamilton, James C. Hamilton, & others son
 of the said Calvin Hamilton of the said lands.
 Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid after having
 seen the proofs and allegations & being satisfied in the premises
 did thereupon make an order that an assessment of the
 same with the said Calvin Hamilton, be made of the terms of the
 said Calvin Hamilton late late deceased, set forth
 in his said petition, and herein described, being the one third
 part thereof, and that Calvin Tiffany, William Mearns,
 and Calvin Goodwin, being legal and rightful free
 holders, & applicants, commissioners for the purpose of making
 said assessment.
 And whereas the Sheriff aforesaid in pursuance
 of the order aforesaid on the several Statutes of
 the State aforesaid, in such case made and provided, do
 hereby appoint you the said Calvin Tiffany, William Mearns
 - Mearns, and Calvin Goodwin, Commissioners to assess and
 lay out as speedily as possible, and among the one
 third part of the lands therein mentioned and described in the
 said Calvin Hamilton, for his said deceased, and in ma-
 - king said assessment, you are to take in view any
 permanent improvements made upon the said lands and
 premises of the said Calvin Hamilton or any other owner
 or owner of the same with the said Calvin Hamilton, and if
 - there shall be any such improvements, within that part
 not allotted to the said Calvin Hamilton, and if not pro-
 - vided so to credit the same as to make a Deduction from the
 said lands and premises allotted to the said Calvin Hamilton
 she will derive from such part of the said improvements
 as shall be included in the section aforesaid, being
 requiring you to make a full and ample report of
 your proceedings with the quantity, course and distance
 of the said lands & premises, allotted to the said Calvin Hamilton
 - with a description of the parts, names, and other per-
 - manent improvements thereof, and the time of your report
 to my Court on the twenty fourth day of June next
 - herein under my said order and seal of Office, at the
 - Town of Albany, in the said County of Albany, this
 - twentieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred
 - and thirty seven.
 Calvin Tiffany, William Mearns, Calvin Goodwin
 do hereby honestly & impartially discharge the duty, and execute
 the trust reposed in me by the Court aforesaid.
