

At a Surrogate Court held in the village of
 Fulton Oswego County on the 19th day of November
 1846 before Wm P Curtis Surrogate
 Michael Nelson B Parsons
 Alva Jennings and Thomas Shepard com-
 missioners appointed pursuant to a former order
 of the said Court on the petition of Mary Solben
 widow of Humphrey Solben deceased for the adme-
 surment of her dower in certain lands and
 tenements of the said Humphrey deceased situate
 in the said County of Oswego when of the said
 deceased did send of an Estate therein in per-
 son this day made report to the said Surrogate
 among other things that after having been duly
 sworn before legal authority faithfully honestly
 and impartially to discharge the duty and
 execute the trust reposed in them by the said
 appointment they did on the 19th day of November 1846
 in the presence of the said Mary Solben (came a
 survey to be made of the lands and premises in
 the said petition appointment and report mentioned
 as reference thereto being had will fully appear and
 caused a map thereof to be made and that
 they had admeasured and allotted to the said Mary
 Solben for her dower the one third part of
 the said lands and premises which said third
 part so admeasured and allotted will fully
 appear in the said report this day filed in
 the office of the said Surrogate and entered at
 large in his minute book kept for that
 purpose and whereas the said Mary Solben
 in the day & at the place just before said
 appeared before the said Surrogate and
 prayed that the said report be confirmed
 and no came appearing to the contrary it
 is therefore ordered that the said report
 and admeasurment be and the same be
 hereby confirmed

I the petitioner Freelove Weed of the town of Richland
 in the said County of Oswego and widow of William Weed
 late of said town deceased, sheweth that the said
 Freelove Weed was lawfully married to the said
 William Weed in his life time and lived and co-
 habited with him until the time of his death which
 was on the twenty fifth (25) day of February A.D.
 1847. That the said William Weed during said marriage
 and cohabitation was seized of an estate of inheritance
 of and in the following lands situate in said County
 of Oswego and that Philip Weed July S. Weed John
 P. Weed Betsey Porter wife of Francis Porter Mary Chapin
 wife of Simon Chapin Cynthia Menter wife of Richard
 Menter Lydia Buck wife of Edward Buck and
 William C. Weed a minor over the age of fourteen years
 and whose general guardian is Norman Root and Fanny
 Weed a minor over the age of fourteen years and Ralph
 Price is her general guardian and Jane Brown wife
 of Isaac H Brown claim to be among the owners and
 as the heirs at law of the said William Weed deceased.
 The following are descriptions of the lands of which
 the said William Weed died seized to wit
 1. "All that certain piece or parcel of land being part
 of lot number thirty one (31) in the twenty first Township
 of Seneca Patent in the town of Richland and County of
 Oswego. Beginning at the South West corner of said lot
 and running from thence North twenty one degrees East
 twenty seven chains fifty links. Thence South Sixty nine
 degrees East twenty one chains seven to five links. Thence
 South twenty one degrees West thirty chains fifty links
 Thence North Sixty nine degrees West four chains
 Thence South twenty one degrees West twelve chains to
 the South line of said lot Thence North sixty nine
 degrees West seventeen chains seven to five links to the
 place of beginning containing fifty five acres as
 surveyed by Robert Gillespie.

2. Also all that certain other piece or parcel of land lying
 in the said town of Richland known and distinguished
 as "one hundred and twenty five acres of land laid
 off on the South end of lot No forty four in Townshite
 No 31 Seneca Patent by a line parallel to the South line
 of said lot" Excepting however out of said 125 acres
