

Twenty acres formerly sold to Asahel Perkins some as follows to wit, Beginning seven chains six and a half links of the S. E. corner of said lot No 44 on the east line of the lot and runs from thence N 21° E along said line twenty six chains thirty four links, thence N 69° W seven chains sixty links, thence south 21° W twenty six chains and thirty four links to a highway, thence along said highway S 67° E seven chains sixty links to the place of beginning. Also excepting and reserving out of said 125 acres two acres and eighty hundredths of an acre bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at the south west corner of said lot No 44 and runs from thence N 31° E along the west line of said lot six chains and two links to the center of a highway, thence along said highway south 71° E four chains forty five links, thence S 20° W six chains thirty four links to the south line of said lot, thence N 69° W along said line four chains six and a half links to the place of beginning leaving of said 125 acres 102 2/3 acres of land, after taking out the two excepted pieces. Also excepting and reserving out of the said piece or parcel of 125 acres all that certain other piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the twenty first township of Scriba's Patent in the town of Richland county of Oswego and is known and distinguished as part of lot number forty four in said patent and is bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at the south east corner of said lot and runs from thence north sixty seven degrees west along the south line of said lot four chains thirty eight links to the center of the highway, thence along said highway north fifty seven degrees thirty minutes east two chains and a half links, thence north sixty one degrees forty five minutes east four chains seventy two links to the east line of said lot, thence south seventy three degrees west along said east line six chains and a half links to the place of beginning containing one acre and thirty nine hundredths of an acre of land to be the same, more or less.

North twenty one degrees East twenty six chains thirty four links to a stake, thence north sixty nine degrees west seven chains sixty links to a stake, thence south twenty one degrees west twenty six chains and thirty four links to a highway running along the south end of the piece of land hereby intended to be conveyed thence south sixty nine degrees East along said highway seven chains sixty links to the place of beginning containing twenty acres of land.

+ Also all that certain other piece or parcel of land lying and being in the town of Richland and county of Oswego on the south side of the highway running by William Meeds to Paige Mill particularly described as being the three acre lot so called in a certain contract given by the said Samuel Perkins to Norman S. Brown bearing date the 22^d of May 1841, and is bounded west by William Meeds, north by highway west by Norman S. Brown and south by Asahel Perkins.
