Whereas Frederic Moore widow of William Need late of the town of Richland in the County of Oswego, & State aforesaid this day presented her petition to C. H. Whitney Esq. Judge of said County of Oswego praying for an order pursuant to the Revised Statutes of this State in such case made and provided that admensurment of her dower be made of the lands of the said William Need deceased situate in the said County to wit

That all that certain piece or parcel of land being part of lot number thirty one (31) in the twenty first Township of Seneca Patent in the County of Richland and County of Oswego. Beginning at the South West Corner of said lot and running from thence North twenty one degrees East twenty seven chains fifty links. Thence South fifty nine degrees East twenty one chains seventy five links. Thence South twenty one degrees West fifteen chains fifty links. Thence thence North fifty nine degrees West <sup>thirty</sup> chains. Thence South twenty one degrees West twelve to the South line of said lot. Thence North fifty nine degrees West twenty seven chains seventy five links to the place of beginning containing fifty five acres as surveyed by Robert Gillespie second. Also all that certain other piece of land lying in the said town of Richland known and distinguished

as one hundred and twenty five acres of land laid off on the South end of lot No forty four in Township No 21 Seneca Patent by a line parallel to the South line of said lot extending however out of said 125 acres twenty acres formerly sold to Rachel Colburn bounded as follows to wit: Beginning South Chain fifteen links to the S.E. Corner of said lot No 44 on the E. line of the lot and run from thence N. 21° E along said line twenty six chains thirty four links. Thence S. 16° W seven chains fifty links. Thence South 21° N twenty six chains and thirty four links to a highway. Thence along said highway S. 64° E seven chains fifty links to the place of beginning. Also extending and measuring out of said 125 acres two acres and eighty hundredths of an acre bounded as follows to wit: beginning at the South West Corner of said lot No 44 and run from thence N. 21° E along the West line of said lot 26 2/3 chains and two links to the Center of highway. Thence along said highway South 71° E four chains forty five links. Thence S. 20° W 24 chains thirty four links to the South line of said lot. Thence N. 64° W along said line four chains fifty four to the place of beginning leaving of said 125 acres 102 20/100 of an acre of land after taking out the two aforesaid pieces. Also extending and measuring out of the said piece or parcel of 125 acres all that certain other piece or parcel of land lying and being in the twenty first Township of Seneca Patent in the town of Richland County of Oswego and is known and distinguished as part of lot number forty four in said Patent and is bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at the South East Corner of said lot and run from thence North 21° E seven degrees West along the South line of said lot four chains thirty eight links to the center of the highway. Thence along said highway North fifty seven degrees thirty minutes East two chains seventy five links. Thence North fifty one degrees forty five minutes East four chains seventy five links to the East line of said lot. Thence South 21° East along thence degrees West along said East line 24 chains thirteen links to the place of beginning containing one acre and thirty nine hundredths of an acre of land be the same more or less.
