That the said Thomas Soul during marriage and cohabitation aforesaid was seized of an estate of an inheritance of and in the following lands which are situate in said County to wit - That certain piece or parcel of land known as part of lot 37 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> township of Sariba patent and described as follows - Beginning at the South East corner of said lot No 57 and running thence North 69 degrees West 19 chains 57 links to lands belted to Constant Soul, thence North 21 degrees East along Constance Soul's east line until it intersects the highway thence along the highway until it intersects the north line of said lot 26 chains 10 links, thence South 69 degrees East to the east line of said lot, thence South 21 degrees West along said line 26 chains 10 links to the place of beginning - containing 48 acres of land be the same more or less -
