

The people of the State of New York To Myrard Broesbeck, of the town and county of Oswego and State of New York, the son of Walter M. Broesbeck late of the said town of same deceased intestate and being: Whereas Walter M. Broesbeck late departed this life intestate being at or immediately previous to his death an intestate of the County of Oswego, by means whereof the ordinary and Granting Administration of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits whereof the said intestate died possessed in the County of Oswego, and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the account thereof debts and liabilities: And we being desirous that the goods Chattels and Credits of the said intestate may be well faithfully administered applied and disposed of, do present unto you the said Myrard Broesbeck full power by these presents to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said goods Chattels and Credits to such demand recover and receive the debts which unto the said intestate wholist living and at the time of his death did belong: and to pay the debts which the said intestate did owe: as far as such goods Chattels and Credits will thereto extend and the law require: hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said intestate within a reasonable time, and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents: And if further personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof and return the same within two months after discovery thereof, and also to render a just and true account of Administration when therunto required, and to do by these presents duly constituted and appointed you the said Myrard Broesbeck Administrator of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said Walter M. Broesbeck deceased.

In testimony whereof we have caused the seal of office of the surrogate's court of said county to be hereunto affixed. Witness Orin H. Whitney County Judge of said County at the village of Mexico the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May in the second year of the hundred and forty ninth of our said County.

The people of the State of New York To all to whom these presents shall come or may concern send greeting: Know ye that at Mexico in the County of Oswego on the twenty eighth day of May A.D. 1849 before Orin H. Whitney County Judge of our said County the written will of Marvin Henderson deceased a Marine who died at sea, was proved and is now approved and allowed by us: and the said Testator at or immediately previous to his death being an inhabitant of or having left assets which then were, or have since come within the said County of Oswego, by reason whereof the proving and registering said will, and granting administration of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said Testator and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the account thereof do belong unto the County Judge of the said County: The Administration of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased and in any way concerning his will is granted unto Sophia M. Henderson the Executrix in the said will named she having first taken and subscribed an oath or affirmation faithfully and honestly to discharge the duties of such Executrix: hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said Testator within a reasonable time, and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego, within three months from the date of these presents: And if further personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made, shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof and return the same within two months after discovery thereof and also to render a just and true account of the Administration when therunto required.
