

The People of the State of New York So My said Proved, of the town and county of Oswego and State of New York, the son of: (Walter M. Braasch late of the said town & county deceased intestate) said: Whereas Walter M. Braasch late departed this life intestate being at or immediately previous to his death an intestate of the County of Oswego, by means whereof the ordinary and Granting Administration of all and singular things of Chattels and Credits whereof the said intestate died possessed in the County of Oswego, and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the account thereof doth appertain to us: And we being desirous that the goods Chattels and Credits of the said intestate may be well faithfully administered applied and disposed of, do grant unto you the said My said Proved full power by these presents to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said goods Chattels and Credits to wit demand recover and receive the debts which unto the said intestate whilst living and at the time of his death did belong: and to pay the debts which the said intestate did owe, as far as such goods Chattels and Credits will thereto extend, and the law require, hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said intestate within a reasonable time, and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents: And if further personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof, and return the same within two months after discovery thereof, and also to render a just and true account of Administration when thereunto required, and we do by these presents constitute and appoint you the said My said Proved Administrator of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said Walter M. Braasch deceased.

Whitney County Judge of our said County the written will of Marvin Henderson deceased a Marine who died at sea, was proved and is now approved and allowed by us: and the said Testator at or immediately previous to his death, being an intestate of or having left assets which then were, or have since come within the said County of Oswego, by reason whereof, the proving and registering said will, and granting administration of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said Testator and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the account thereof do belong unto the County Judge of the said County: The Administration of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased and in any way concerning the same is granted unto Sophia M. Henderson the Executrix in the said will named she having first taken and subscribed an oath or affirmation faithfully and honestly to discharge the duties of such Executrix: hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said Testator within a reasonable time, and return a duplicate thereof, to our County Judge of the County of Oswego, within three months from the date of these presents: And if further personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made, shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof and return the same within two months after discovery thereof and also to render a just and true account of the Administration when thereunto required.
