And we do by these presents, depute constitute and appoint you the said Allen Chaffee guardian as aforesaid, administrator of all & singular the goods, chattels & credits which were of the said Samuel Mosher deceased, by testimony whereof we have caused the seal of the Superior Court of our said County of Oswego to be hereunto affixed.
