Whereas James W. Boomer late departed this life, intestate being at or immediately previous to his death an inhabitant of the County of Oswego, by means whereof the ordering and granting Administration of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits whereof the said intestate died possessed in the state of New York, and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the account thereof, shall appear as follows: And we being desirous that the goods, Chattels & credits of the said intestate may be faithfully administered, applied & disposed of, do grant unto you the said Anna Boomer full power by these presents to administer & faithfully dispose of all & singular the said goods, Chattels & credits, to wit, I mean money and means the which unto the said intestate which living, and at the time of his death did belong; and to pay the debts which the said intestate did owe as far as such goods, Chattels and credits will thereto extend and the law requires hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory, full and singular the goods, Chattels & credits of the said intestate within a reasonable time, and return a duplicate thereof to our surrogate of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents, and if further personal property or assets of any kind, not mentioned in any inventory that shall be so made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof; and also to render a just and true account of the Administration when thereunto required. And we do by these presents constitute and appoint you the said Anna Boomer Administratrix of all and singular the goods, Chattels and Credits of the said James W. Boomer, deceased.

Know ye that at Merice in the County of Oswego on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1849 before Orin H. Whitney County Judge of our said County the last will and testament of James Ferguson deceased, was proved and is now approved and allowed by us. And the said testator at or immediately previous to his death being an inhabitant of, or having left assets which then were so have since come within the said County of Oswego by reason whereof the proving and registering of the said will, and granting Administration of all and singular the goods, Chattels and Credits of the said testator, and also the auditing, allowing & final discharging the account thereof do belong unto the County Judge of the said County. The Administration of all and singular the goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased & by any way concerning his will is granted unto Henry Mellin and John Patten Executors in the said will named they having first taken and subscribed an oath or affirmation faithfully and honestly to discharge the duties of such Executors; hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels and Credits of the said testator within a reasonable time and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents, and if further personal property or assets of any kind, not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof, and return the same within two months after discovery thereof, and also to render a just and true account of the Administration when thereunto required.
