

The People of the State of New York to Leonis Clark in the right & behalf of Euanda Clark his wife send greeting:

Whereas William H Smith as is alleged lately died intestate being at or immediately previous to his death an inhabitant of or having left assets which then were, or have since come within the County of Oswego, by means whereof the ordering and granting administration of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits, of which the said intestate died possessed, and also the auditing allowing and finally discharging the account thereof do belong unto our County Judge of the County of Oswego: And we being desirous that the goods, chattels and credits of the said intestate shall be well and faithfully administered applied and disposed of do Grant unto you the said Leonis Clark in the right and behalf of said full power by these presents to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said goods, chattels and credits, to ask demand receive and receive the debts which unto the said intestate whilst living & at the time of his death did belong: And to pay the debts which the said intestate did owe as far as such goods, chattels and credits will thereto extend & the law require: hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels & credits of the said intestate, within a reasonable time and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents, and if further personal property of any other kind, not mentioned in any inventory that shall hereafter be made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof within two months after the coming thereof

And we do by these presents, deputate constitute and appoint you the said Leonis Clark in the right & behalf of our said Administrator of all and singular the goods, chattels & credits which were of the said William H Smith deceased.

The People of the State of New York to George Dowler of Orleans in the County of Jefferson Legate under the last will and testament of Mary Dowler late of Onondaga deceased.

Whereas the said Mary Dowler lately departed this life having previously duly made and executed her last will and testament: And whereas said will (a copy whereof is hereto annexed) was on third day of December in the year A.D. 1849 admitted to probate by Orlu H Whitney County Judge of the County of Oswego: And whereas the Executors named in said will have duly renounced their Executorship: And the said Mary Dowler at or immediately previous to her death was an inhabitant of the County of Oswego, by means whereof the proving and registering of said will and the ordering and granting administration of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits whereof the said testatrix died possessed in the State of New York, and also the auditing, allowing and finally discharging the account thereof do happen unto us: And we being desirous that the said will should be proved and performed and that the goods, chattels and credits of the said testatrix should be well and faithfully administered applied and disposed of do Grant unto you the said George Dowler full power and authority by these presents, to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said goods, chattels and credits, and to ask demand receive and receive the debts which unto the said testatrix whilst living and at the time of her death did belong, and to pay the debts which the said testatrix did owe as far as such goods, chattels & credits will thereto extend and the law require: hereby requiring you to observe and perform the said last will and testament, and to observe and perform all the duties to which you would have been subject if you had been named the executor thereof: And we do by these presents, deputate constitute and appoint you the said George Dowler, Administrator with the will annexed of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits which were of the said Mary Dowler deceased,
