

The people of the state of New York do hereby give and grant unto John F. Hoceum and meeting

Whereas Eliazur Hoceum as is alleged lately died intestate being at or immediately previous to his death an inhabitant of or having left assets which then were or have since come within the County of Oswego by means whereof the ordering and granting Administration of all singular the goods, chattels & credits of which the said intestate died possessed, and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the account thereof do belong unto our County Judge of the County of Oswego: And we being desirous that the goods, Chattels and credits of the said intestate shall be well and faithfully administered, applied and disposed of Do grant unto you the said John F. Hoceum full power by these presents to administer and faithfully dispose of all singular the said goods, Chattels & credits to ask demand receive and receive the debts which unto the said intestate which living and at the time of his death did belong: And to pay the debts which the said intestate did owe as far as such goods, Chattels and credits will therein extend and the law requires: hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels and credits of the said intestate within a reasonable time and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents: And if further personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof within two months after the discovery thereof

And we do by these presents depute constitute and appoint you the said John F. Hoceum Administrator of all and singular the goods Chattels and credits which were of the said Eliazur Hoceum deceased.

Know all that the Justice in the County of Oswego on the 10th day of December A.D. 1849 before Orla H. Whitney County Judge of our said County the last will and Testament of Joseph Austin deceased was proved and is now approved and allowed by us: And the said testator at or immediately previous to his death being an inhabitant of or having left assets which then were or have since come within the said County of Oswego by reason whereof the proving and registering of the said will and granting Administration of all singular the goods, Chattels and credits of the said testator and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the account thereof do belong unto our County Judge of the said County: This Administration of all singular the goods, Chattels and credits of the said deceased in any way concerning his will is granted unto Joseph Austin the Executor in the said will named he having first taken and subscribed an oath or affirmation faithfully and honestly to discharge the duties of such Executor: hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels and credits of the said testator within a reasonable time and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months from the date of these presents: And if further personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any inventory that shall have been so made shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof and return the same within two months after the discovery thereof: And also to render a just and true account of the Administration when thereunto required.
