Whereas Nancy Williams, as is alleged, lately died
intestate, being at or immediately previous to her death, an in-
habitant of, or having left assets which then were or have
since come within the county of Oswego, by means whereof
the ordering & granting administration of all and singular
the goods, chattels & credits of which the said intestate died
seised, and also the auditing, allowing & final discharging the
accounts thereof, do belong unto our County Judge of the County
of Oswego; And we being desirous that the goods, chattels &
credits of the said intestate shall be well & faithfully ad-
ministered, applied & disposed of, Do Grant unto you the said
Nancy Williams, John P Rice & William Hale full power by
their presents, to administer faithfully & dispose of all singular the
said goods, chattels & credits; to ask demand receive & receive the
debts which unto the said intestate, whilst living & at the time
of his death did belong; And to pay the debts which the
said intestate did owe, as far as such goods, chattels, and
credits will thereto extend; & the said receiving hereby requiring
you to make or cause to be made a true & perfect inventory
of all singular the goods, chattels & credits of the said intestate
within a reasonable time; And retain a duplicate
thereof, to our County Judge of the County of Oswego, within
three months from the date of these presents; And if either
personal property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any
inventory that shall have been so made, shall come to
your possession or knowledge, to make or cause to be made
in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof,
within two months after discovering thereof.

And we do by these presents, appoint constitute and
appoint you the said Nancy Williams, John P Rice and
William Hale administrators of all and singular the goods,
chattels & credits which were of the said Nancy Williams
decease.

to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular

reasonable time and retain a duplicate thereof to our
County Judge of the County of Oswego within three months
from the date of these presents; And if either personal
property or assets of any kind not mentioned in any
inventory that shall have been so made, shall come
to your possession or knowledge, to make or cause to be made
in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof
and return the same within two months after discovering
thereof and also to render a just and true account
of the administration when the same shall be required.
