

The People of the State of New York To Jesse Van Horn
Send Greeting:

Whereas Sarah Bankome as is alleged lately died intestate having whilst living & at the time of her death goods chattels & credits within this state by means whereof she ordering & granting administration of all & singular the said goods chattels & credits and also the auditing allowing and finally discharging the accounts thereof doth appertain unto us: And we being desirous that the said goods chattels and credits of the said deceased might be well and faithfully administered applied and disposed of do grant unto you the said Jesse Van Horn full power by these presents to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said goods chattels and credits to wit demand receive and receive the debts which unto the said deceased whilst living and at the time of her death did belong: And to pay the debts which the said deceased did owe so far as said goods chattels and credits will thereto extend: And the law requires hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true & perfect inventory of all and singular the said goods chattels & credits of the said deceased which then or shall come to your hands possession or knowledge: Also to make or cause duplicate of such inventory & cause the same to be signed by the appraisers and the same to be made and signed that you make return thereof to the surrogate of the County of Oswego within three months from the date hereof: And further to render a just and true account of your administration when thereunto required: And we do by these presents depute constitute and appoint you Administrator of all and singular the goods chattels and credits which were of the said deceased.

The People of the State of New York To Willcut Barnes of Sand Bank Oswego County Legate under the last will & testament of Delana M Barnes late of Sand Bank Oswego County deceased: Whereas the said Delana M Barnes lately departed this life having previously duly made & executed her last will and testament: And whereas the said will (a copy whereof is hereto annexed) was on the tenth day of June one thousand eight hundred and fifty duly admitted to probate by Orla H Whitney County Judge as surrogate of Oswego County: And the executors thereof having been re-nounced their appointment as named in said will: And whereas the said Delana M Barnes at or immediately previous to her death was an inhabitant of the county of Oswego by means whereof the proving & regulating of said will & the ordering & granting administration of all and singular the goods chattels & credits whereof the said testatrix did possess in the state of New York: And also the auditing allowing & finally discharging the accounts thereof doth appertain unto us: And we being desirous that the said will should be observed & performed & that the goods chattels & credits of said testatrix should be well & faithfully administered applied & disposed of do grant unto you the said Willcut Barnes full power and authority by these presents to administer & faithfully dispose of all & singular the said goods chattels & credits & to ask demand receive & receive the debts which unto the said testatrix whilst living & at the time of her death did belong: and to pay the debts which the said testatrix did owe as far as such goods chattels & credits will thereto extend & the law requires hereby requiring you to observe & perform the said last will and testament and to observe & perform all the duties which you would have been subject if you had been named executor thereof: And we do by these presents depute constitute & appoint you the said Willcut Barnes Administrator with the will annexed of all and singular the goods chattels & credits which were of the said Delana M Barnes deceased.
