Deed Granting :-

Whereas Samuel Collins as is alleged, lately died intestate, being at or immediately previous to his death an inhabitant of, or having left effects which then were or have since come within the County of Oswego, by means whereof the ordering and granting administration of all and singular the goods, Chattels & Credits of which the said intestate died possessed, and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the account thereof do belong unto our County Judge of the County of Oswego: And we, being desirous that the goods, Chattels and Credits of the said intestate shall be well and faithfully administered, applied and disposed of, Do Grant unto you, the said Halsey Collins full power by these Presents, to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said Goods Chattels and Credits: to ask, demand, recover and receive the Debts which unto the said intestate whilst living and at the time of his death did belong: and to pay the debt which the said intestate did owe as far as such Goods, Chattels and Credits will thereto extend, and the law requires; hereby requiring you to make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels and Credits of the said intestate, within a reasonable time and return a duplicate thereof to our County Judge of the County of Oswego, within three months from the date of these Presents, and if further personal property or effects of any kind not mentioned in any inventory, that shall have been so made, shall come to your possession or knowledge to make or cause to be made, in like manner a true and perfect inventory thereof within two months after discovery thereof.

And we do, by these Presents, define constitute and appoint you the said Halsey Collins Administrator of all and singular the goods, Chattels, and Credits which were of the said Samuel Collins - deceased.

Deed Granting:
