Free and Independent: To *Henry Rust*  
of the town of *Islip* in the county of *Suffolk*,  
send GREETING:

WHEREAS *Josh Rust* late of *Islip*

*deceased in said County of Suffolk*

as is alleged, lately died intestate, having whilst living, and at the time of *his* death, goods, chattels, or credits within this state, by means whereof the ordering and granting administration of all and singular the said goods, chattels and credits; and also the auditing, allowing, and finally discharging the account thereof, doth appertain unto us; and we, being desirous that the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased may be well and faithfully administered, applied and disposed of, do grant unto you the said *Henry Rust* full

power by these presents, to administer and faithfully dispose of all and singular the said goods, chattels and credits, to ask, demand, recover and receive the debts, which unto the said deceased, whilst living, and at the time of *his* death did belong, and to pay the debts which the said deceased did owe, so far as said goods, chattels and credits will thereto extend, and the law require; Hereby requiring you to make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to your hands, possession or knowledge, and the same so made, to exhibit, or cause to be exhibited into the office of the Surrogate of the said county of *Suffolk* at or before the expiration of six calendar months from the date hereof; and also to render a just and true account of administration when thereunto required; And we do by these Presents, depute, constitute and appoint you the said *Henry Rust*

Administrator of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits which were of the said *Josh Rust* deceased at the time of *his* death

In testimony whereof, we have caused the Seal of Office of our said Surrogate to be hereunto affixed.

time of *his* death was duly sworn by the Jurors  
of the said County to *Elizeha* and *Elizabeth*  
Jurors of which the foregoing is a Copy and  
that they the said *Elizeha* and *Elizabeth* Jurors were lawfully  
sworn before the said Surrogate and the said *Henry Rust*  
that the deceased made no will so far as they  
knew or believed; And that they would to the  
best of their ability well and faithfully administer the  
said goods, Chattels and Credits by paying the  
debts due to the said deceased and the law requires and that  
they would to the best of their ability render a  
true and perfect inventory of all and singular the  
goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased  
and the same so made to exhibit into the office of the said Surrogate at
