An Order to show cause herein having been duly
granted upon the Petition of John T. Holt, the
Executor herein, returnable upon the 25th day
of January, 1904 upon which day the said
Executor appeared by his attorney Elisha B. Powell
and filed due proofs of service of said Order
to show cause or waiver of service thereof upon
all the legatees named in the Will of the said
Orson H Brown, deceased, and no one appeared
in the behalf of any of the said legatees except
William B. Baker, Esq., who appeared as Attorney
herein for Harriet N. Wilkin, one of the said legatees
and, after hearing the attorneys aforesaid for
the respective parties, the said proceeding was
further adjourned until February 4, 1904.

And it appearing from the petition herein
and from the evidence taken herein in open
Court that the provisions of said will as
quoted in said petition are therein correctly
stated; that the house and lot referred to
in said will, which was the homestead of the
said Orson H Brown was sold by the Executor
herein together with the carpets and some
of the furniture contained in said house for
the sum of \$5000.00 and that the expenses
and commissions of making said sale are
\$137.25 leaving a net balance from the sale
of said house and said furniture of \$4862.15
and it further appearing that such sale was
made with the consent of Ellen Shankland
to whom was devised "the occupancy and free
use" and the agreement and understanding
between her and the said Executor that in
lieu of the occupancy and free use of said
dwelling house, she should pay the cash
value thereof; and it further appearing that the
rental value of said house is at least
