

At a term of Surrogate Court held in and for the County of Oswego at the Surrogate's Office in the City of Oswego on the 29th day of February 1914

Present Hon. S. B. Innes, Surrogate.

In the estate of Eliza M. Fisher,
Late of Pulaski, Deceased.

On reading and filing the petition of Mary A. Innes, a residuary legatee under the last will and testament of said Eliza M. Fisher, verified on the 15th day of February, 1914, from which it appears that Mr. A. F. Betts of Pulaski, N.Y. is the executor of said estate and that he has paid, or claims to have paid, certain demands and claims against said estate which petitioner alleges are unjust, extravagant and illegal, and that said executor has not taken proper legal measures to contest and cause to be examined any alleged claim presented by one Laura Roberts for about \$2000.00 for her alleged services as a servant in the family of deceased, though she is a devisee and legatee for a large sum under said will, and has not taken proper measures to protect the rights and interests of said residuary legatee as to the payment of the claims aforesaid and on reading and filing the affidavit of N. B. Smith, Esq., of Counsel for said residuary legatee, showing that said Betts has neglected to show him and permit him to examine the books of account, Memorandum books and papers kept by and for said testatrix relating to the business and financial transactions between testatrix and said Laura Roberts and other claimants who have presented demands against said estate, though often requested so to do, and on all the papers filed and proceedings had and taken in said estate in this Court

Now, on motion of N. B. Smith, of Counsel for said Mary A. Innes, it is ordered, that said A. F. Betts, as such executor be, and he hereby is, enjoined

and restrained from making any further payment or payments to the said Laura Roberts upon the said claim until the final judicial settlement of his accounts as such Executor, or until the further order of this Court.
