appearing in open Court by their Attorneys and said parties
having been heard - Now therefore having heard the proofs of

final hearing was had ^{and the matter having been fully argued on this day} It is hereby ordered adjudged
and decreed that the probate heretofore granted by this Court
on the said instrument as and for the last Will and Testament
of the said Emily Allen be and the same is hereby sustained and
affirmed without costs to either party.
