Robbins, and had taken his receipt and release in full therefor, (which was on the back of said petition,) and that there was nothing now in the hands of said Newton Cook as such guardian, belonging to him and nothing due from him as such guardian to the said Benjamin S. Robbins, and praying that upon reading and filing said petition, and the receipt, release and discharge on the back of the same, (and which was duly acknowledged) that an order and decree be immediately made by the Surrogate's Court of the county of Oswego, New York, adjudging said matter fully settled, and releasing and discharging the said Newton Cook, and the person or persons who signed his bond as such guardian from all further liability and accountability in the matter.

Now, therefore, on reading and filing said petition, receipt, release and discharge it is ordered, adjudged and decreed that the prayer of said petitioners be and the same is hereby granted.
