S. Sherman as such guardian, belonging to him and nothing due from him as such guardian to the said Percy Beebe, and praying that upon reading and filing said petition, and the receipt, release and discharge on the back of the same, (and which was duly acknowledged) that an order and decree be immediately made by the Surrogate's Court of the county of Oswego, New York, adjudging said matter fully settled, and releasing and discharging the said L. S. Sherman, and the person or persons who signed his bond as such guardian from all further liability and accountability in the matter.
