An order having been heretofore made by the  
Surrogate of Oswego County, N.Y. that said Cornelius  
Smedley, as general guardian of Anna Van Buren, an  
infant file his account for final settlement herein  
(over)

and said guardian having rendered his account  
under oath, before said Surrogate, and the said  
account having been filed together with some  
vouchers in support thereof, and objections to  
said account having been filed by William  
Cooper as general guardian of said infant, duly  
appointed as such by the <sup>Surrogate of said</sup> County to supervise  
said Smedley, and an order of reference having  
been made referring said account, and ob-  
jections to C. H. David Esq. of Fulton, N.Y. said  
referee having made his report herein said  
report having been confirmed, the said Surrogate  
after having examined the said report & the evidence  
and said account & vouchers, now here finds  
the state & condition of said account to be as  
stated set forth in the following summary  
statement thereof made by the said Surrogate  
as finally settled & adjusted by him to be re-  
corded with & taken to be a part of the decree in  
this matter, to wit:

A summary statement of the account of Cornelius  
A. Smedley as general guardian of Anna Van Buren  
an infant, made by the Surrogate as finally  
settled and allowed.

The said guardian is chargeable with the  
sum of \$593.90 together with the sum of \$71.26  
interest for two years making in all the sum  
\$665.16. Said guardian is credited with  
the sum of \$156.00 for board & clothing said  
infant, leaving a balance of \$509.16 in  
said former guardian's hands on Feb'y 17th.  
1892, which sum together with \$38.86 interest thereon  
from Feb'y 17th, 1892 to the date of this decree  
making in all \$548.02, now in the hands of  
said former guardian.

And it appearing that said former guardian  
has fully accounted for all the moneys and  
property of said infant which have come into  
his hands as such guardian & his account  
having been adjusted by said Surrogate  
& a summary statement of the same  
having been made as above & herewith  
recorded. It is hereby ordered, adjudged
