

and decreed that the said account be and the same is hereby finally & judicially settled and allowed as admitted, & it is further ordered and decreed that said Cornelius A. Smedley personally pay to William Cooper as General Guardian of said infant said sum of \$548.02 and \$50.00 costs together with \$37.50 disbursement as toward amounting in all to \$635.90 for his debt & costs on the accounting herein.

And it is further ordered that upon so doing he be discharged from all further liability as general guardian of said Anna Van Buren an infant and freed of & from all responsibility to said infant on account of his acts & doings as such guardian and on his failure or neglect so to do that said William Cooper have execution therefor.
