In the matter of the final accounting of Henry M. Carleton as general guardian of Elizabeth J. Underdown, now Elizabeth J. M. Hallard.

The above named infant now of full age having made her petition to the Surrogate Court in her removal of Elizabeth Underdown Hallard asking that Henry M. Carleton, her general guardian be cited to appear in said Court & give an account of his trust as such guardian & such relation having been duly served & the same having been returned with due proof of service & the said guardian having appeared & sworn & filed his account & the said Elizabeth Underdown Hallard having appeared by H. H. Backwell her counsel & the proceedings having been adjourned to the term above entitled to wit at Pulaaki, N. Y. on March 6, 1895.

And the said parties having again appeared & the Court having duly examined the said account & having examined the said guardian & under oath in reference thereto & the said guardian having delivered to the petitioner the possession of all her real estate together with all deeds & papers relating thereto  
And the Surrogate having found

that the said guardian has fully accounted for all monies & other property of his said ward that have come to his hands including the rents, issues & profits of all her real estate except the sum of Seventy five dollars (\$75.00) received by him near about March, 1890 from the Onondaga County Savings Bank. Now therefore, it is adjudged that Henry M. Carleton as such guardian is indebted to Elizabeth J. Underdown Hallard in the amount of Eighty Dollars being the above mentioned amount with interest from the date he received the same at four per cent per annum less \$10.00 costs of this proceeding to the final judgment.

It is further ordered & adjudged, that the said Henry M. Carleton as such guardian pay to the said Elizabeth J. Underdown Hallard, his said ward, or to H. H. Backwell her attorney within sixty days from this date the said amount last above stated to wit Eighty dollars & that upon such payment he be discharged & released of and from all liability to the said Elizabeth J. M. Hallard on account of his acts as such guardian, that all his said acts as such guardian be thereupon fully ratified & confirmed, & that the said Henry M. Carleton & the sureties on his official bond be thereupon fully discharged from all liability to the said Elizabeth J. M. Hallard on account of his said guardianship
