In the Name of God, Amen, I, Nancy May
 widow of Hancock May of the Town of New
 Haven in the County of New York and State of
 New York being of sound mind and memory
 and considering the nearness of this frail
 and transitory life, do hereby make, ordain,
 publish and declare this to be my last will
 and testament, that is to say:
 First - after all my lawful debts are paid
 and discharged and funeral expenses paid
 I give and bequeath to my son Charles
 May ten to five Dollars.
 Second - I give and bequeath to my grand-
 daughter Helen May wife of Amanda Hammond
 one feather bed with bedding and one white
 linen table cloth and one gown of my wardrobe
 and one avails of my money consisting of mortgages
 & notes & money in the Bank.
 Thirdly - I give and bequeath to my grand-
 daughter L. May one silver table spoon
 and one gown of all my money consisting of
 mortgages and money in Bank and notes after
 the first request to my son Charles.
 Fourthly - I give and bequeath to my grand-
 daughter Fannetta May daughter of my son
 Erskine May one feather bed and bedding and
 my small bureau and one fourth of my money
 & other obligations I may leave after deducting
 the first request to my son Charles.
 Fifth and last - I give and bequeath to my grand-
 son Charles A. May who has cared for me kindly
 my share in the stock and farming tools and
 all the balance of the household furniture and
 one quarter of all the proceeds after deducting
 the request to my son Charles (namely) of my
 money & obligations hereinbefore described.
 In witness whereof I make, constitute and appoint George
 W. Farnes of New York City, in the County of New York
 of this my last will and testament, hereby making
 all former wills by me made.
